We are taking precautionary measures at OT FOR TOTS to ensure the safety and well-being of our clients, parents, and staff.

We are implementing the following measures to ensure the health and well-being of everyone:

1. Disinfecting the clinic daily with recommended chemicals by the CICD.
2. Conducting a screener for every client:
 1. Have Fever, dry cough, or body aches
 2. Been sick or presenting with flu like symptoms
 3. Been in contact with someone who has been exposed
 4. Been out of town within the last 14 days
3. Hand washing with every child that enters the clinic
4. Cleaning client’s work area after the session
